FAMILY SELF SUFFICIENC (FSS) PROGRAM



The Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Program is a voluntary multi-year work and saving program for families receiving CRHA housing assistance. The FSS program assists participants to set long and short-term goals that will increase their ability to earn a greater income and move towards self-sufficiency.

Working with a dedicated FSS Coordinator, participants identify obstacles and set targets to address any challenges and overcome barriers by connection to referrals with community partners that can provide supportive services and move participants closer to where they want to be. Participants in the FSS program have earned higher education and job/skilled training, built a savings account, bought a reliable vehicle, secured new and stable work, and much more!

Who can participate?

Open to families in CRHA's Public Housing (PH), the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program & residents of project-based rental assistance (PBRA) projects.
