Please note that your criminal record must include Charlottesville and/or Albemarle charges to expunge at this clinic.

If you do not qualify for free filing, filing fees to open expungements cases will be covered on a first-come, first serve basis while funds last.

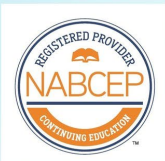

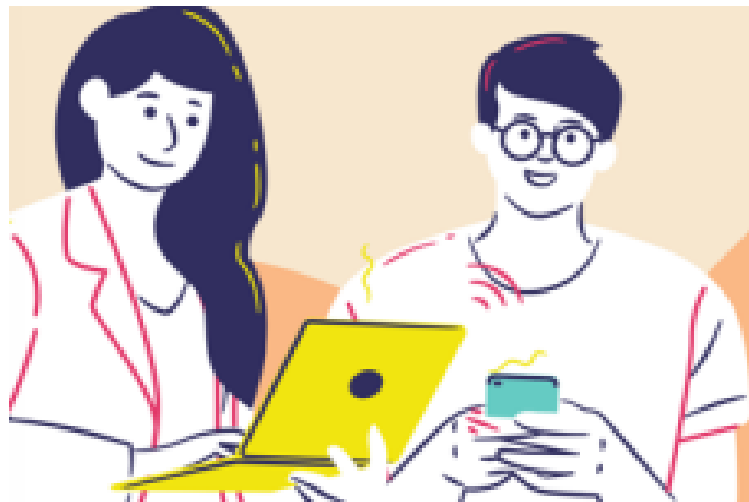

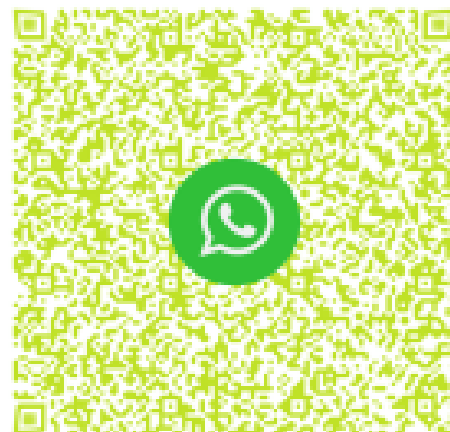
